



IPCC MANDATE


The IPCC was established to provide the decision-makers and others interested in climate change with an objective source of information about climate change. The IPCC does not conduct any research nor does it monitor climate related data or parameters. Its role is to assess on a **comprehensive**, **objective**, **open and transparent** basis the latest scientific, technical and socio-economic literature produced worldwide relevant to the understanding of the risk of human-induced climate change, its observed and projected impacts and options for adaptation and mitigation. IPCC reports should be neutral with respect to policy, although they need to deal objectively with policy-relevant scientific, technical and socio-economic factors. They should be of high scientific and technical standards, and aim to reflect a range of views, expertise and wide geographical coverage.





Comparison of Temperature History as Presented in First & Third IPCC Reports








(Corrected) Figure 1.3: Surface temperature anomalies From: Climate Change 2009, Science Compendium, UNEP





Temperature Changes from more than 30 Years of Satellite Observations





Antarctic Ice Core Data 1





On average CO2 rises and falls hundreds of years after temperature does.


World Temperatures Falling Whilst CO₂ Keeps Rising



No Significant Warming Between 30° North and 30° South


TEMPERATURE DIFFERENCES BETWEEN DECEMBER 1, 1978 AND NOVEMBER 30, 2008

LAYER = LT LOWER TROPOSPHERE




Each contour represents 0.2 C per decade warming or cooling between Dec. 1, 1979, and Nov. 30, 2008, starting at ± 0.1 C

Percent Change in Predicted Rainfall - 1990 to 2090 - Two Climate Models




Fingerprint test is negative: Modeled and observed temperature patterns disagree



CCSP 1.1 – Chapter 1, Figure 1.3F PCM Simulations of Zonal-Mean Atmospheric Temperature Change



NIPCC Conclusions:

- Obs show no detectable human fingerprint
- Models overestimate GHG effect—neg feedbk
- CO2 is not a pollutant—mitigation pointless
- Sea level rise will continue at its normal rate of 18cm (7 inches) per century
- Natural climate change is mostly the result of variable solar activity

WV Feedbacks and Clouds


- Water vapor feedback (pos in GH models, but may be neg in atm -- dep on UTWV)
- Water (liquid) as cloud droplets
- Water (solid) as cirrus ice particles ("iris effect")
- Evidence obtainable from SWR/OLR (AIRS satellite, etc) vs Time and Latitude

Solar Changes → Climate Change Cloudiness controlled by solar activity

- Solar Wind and Magnetic Field ->
- Modulate Galactic Cosmic Rays ->
- Change cloudiness in Earth atmosphere ->
- Affect amount of Solar energy to surface

• Evidence from $C^{14} - O^{18}$ correlation

Age (kyr BP)


¹⁴C − a Proxy for Solar Activity

The stalagmite record shows a remarkably close correlation between ¹⁴C and ¹⁸O over a period of more than 3,000 years.

Thus, a strong association exists between solar activity and temperature.

EPA- Endangerment Finding

(CO2 is a 'criteria pollutant' – emissions must be controlled)

- We oppose both EPA initiatives on the basis of the NIPCC conclusions against AGW
- EPA has suppressed internal scientific dissent

"If climate is controlled by natural forces, as N-IPCC clearly demonstrates, then regulation of CO2 is not only pointless and ineffective -- but also very costly. **It's all pain and no gain**.

To sum up:

**We reject the current climate models that have not been verified.

**We reject the IPCC conclusion that human activity causes significant warming.

**We urge you to reject the EPA Endangerment Finding as unscientific and fatally flawed."

The Waxman-Markey Cap&Trade bill (passed House on June 26, mostly unread)

- Largest tax in US history
- 85% of permits to favored groups, 15% to Treasury
- Mandates 20% renewables for utilities
- Energy cost ~ \$2000/household
- Job killer as industry moves offshore
- May lead to compensating tariffs and trade wars
- Emission cuts of 17% by 2020, 83% by 2050
- But no measurable impact on CO2 or climate
- All pain and no gain

Cost of Cap&Trade bill - H.R.2454

In an interview with the San Francisco Chronicle in January 2008, President Obama calmly explained how cap-and-trade -- the carbondioxide rationing scheme that is at the heart of Waxman-Markey -- would work: "Under my plan of a cap-and-trade system, electricity rates would necessarily skyrocket . . . because I'm capping greenhouse gases, coal power plants, natural gas, you name it. . . . Whatever the plants were, whatever the industry was, they would have to retrofit their operations. That will cost money, and they will pass that [cost] on to consumers." In the same interview, Obama suggested that his energy policy would require the ruin of the coal industry. "If somebody wants to build a coal-fired plant, they can," he told the Chronicle. "It's just that it will bankrupt them, because they are going to be charged a huge sum for all that greenhouse gas that's being emitted."

Petitioning for a Revised statement on climate change

SIR — We write in response to your issue discussing "the coming climate crunch", including the Editorial 'Time to act' (*Nature* 459, 1077–1078; 2009). We feel it is alarmist.

We are among more than 50 current and former members of the American Physical Society (APS) who have signed an open letter to the APS Council this month, calling for a reconsideration of its November 2007 policy statement on climate change (see open letter at http://tinyurl.com/lg266u; APS statement at http://tinyurl.com/56zqxr). The letter proposes an alternative statement, which the signatories believe to be a more accurate representation of the current scientific evidence. It requests that an objective scientific process be established, devoid of political or financial agendas, to help prevent subversion of the scientific process and the intolerance towards scientific disagreement that pervades the climate issue.

- On 1 May 2009, the APS Council decided to review its current statement via a high-level subcommittee of respected senior scientists. We applaud this decision. It is the first such reappraisal by a major scientific professional society that we are aware of, and we hope it will lead to meaningful change that reflects a more balanced view of climate change issues.

Pre-COP-15 NIPCC Conference in CPH

- Day #1 will establish that the <u>human contribution to global climate</u> <u>change is insignificant</u>, in comparison to natural influences. Cost-benefit analyses are therefore problematic. <u>Emission controls are costly, ineffective, and waste valuable resources</u> that can better be applied to other global societal problems. In addition, emission controls curtail the beneficial use of energy and thereby <u>reduce economic growth</u>, enhance worldwide poverty, create inequities and international trade problems, and threaten individual liberties.



- Only satellite data can give undistorted global coverage – using same instrument







Figure 2. Observed monthly global temperature anomalies since 1950. The red curve is the HadCRUT3v data set of global-mean near-surface air temperature, T_s , the standard meteorological temperature measurement. The blue curve is a 10-year running mean. (Data are from the climatic research unit, University of East Anglia, UK.)

Temperature Trends at 107 Californian Stations 1909 to 1994 Stratified by 1990 population of the county where station is located











